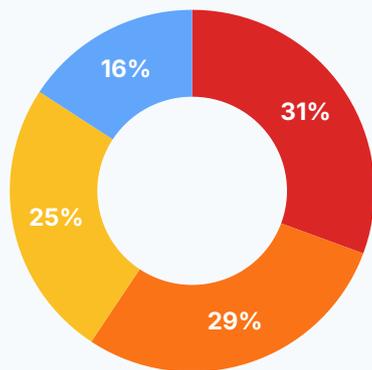

CRITICAL (34 total)

Why this matters

Low-contrast text reduces readability and can prevent users with low vision from accessing content. Navigation labels, instructions, and content may be difficult to read.

Missing alternative text for images

CRITICAL (19 total)

Why this matters

Images without alternative text are not conveyed to screen reader users. Users may miss information that is communicated visually.

Links without discernible text

SERIOUS (27 total)

Why this matters

Links without accessible names are difficult to use with assistive technologies. Users may not understand link purpose or be unable to navigate effectively.

Why this matters

Buttons without accessible names are ambiguous or unusable for screen reader users. Users may not know what a button does or may be unable to operate controls.

Why this matters

Heading structure is used by assistive technologies to understand and navigate content. Users may have difficulty skimming pages and understanding page structure.

METHODOLOGY & LIMITATIONS

The following methodology was used to produce this evidence artefact. Results are subject to the limitations noted below.

Methodology

- Automated accessibility testing using axe-core with WCAG 2.0/2.1 Level A and AA criteria.
- Same-origin, breadth-first crawl starting from the supplied URL.
- JavaScript rendering enabled in headless Chromium.

Limitations

- Automated testing cannot detect all accessibility issues.
- Manual review and user testing remain necessary for full conformance validation.
- Results reflect a point-in-time assessment and may change as the site changes.
